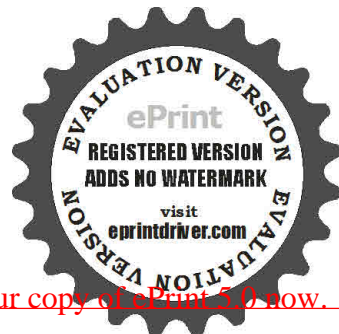

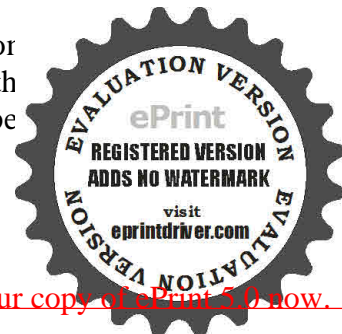

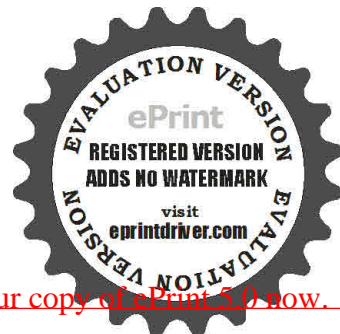

Puzzle Answers

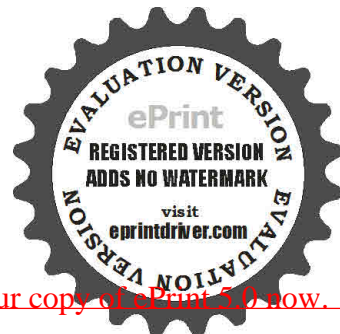
Modern Pentathlon

In addition to the track and field pentathlon many of us know from the Olympics, there is a competition known as the Modern Pentathlon, which is based on the five skills required of a Napoleonic soldier: fencing, horsemanship, running, shooting and swimming. Competitions include both individual and team events. Five prep school teams recently participated in a regional competition. These teams were fairly evenly matched: each team took home one Gold, one Silver and one bronze medal. Determine, for each event, which team won each medal.

1. Neither Crustacean Brothers Academy nor Rinnay School won the Bronze medal for horsemanship.
2. The team that took home the Gold medal for shooting and the Bronze medal for fencing are, in some order, Exchequer Academy and the Rinnay School.
3. Neither Exchequer Academy nor Hauer Prep won the Silver medal shooting
4. Hauer Prep and Pippley Prep didn't both win medals for running.
5. Either Crustacean Brothers Academy or Pippley Prep won the Silver medal for swimming.
6. Exchequer Academy and Hauer Prep didn't both win medals in horsemanship.
7. Pippley Prep didn't win the Bronze medal for shooting.
8. Exchequer Academy picked up a medal for swimming, but it wasn't Bronze.
9. Neither Crustacean Brothers Academy nor Hauer Prep won the Gold for horsemanship.

This chart can help you solve the problem. Enter all of the facts you can from the information given. By process of elimination, you will arrive at the correct solution.
