## Past Events & Highlights

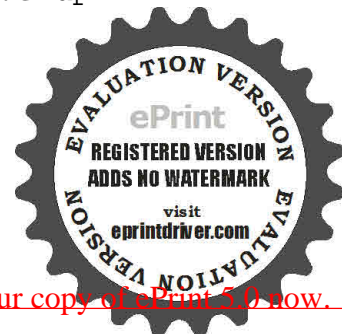

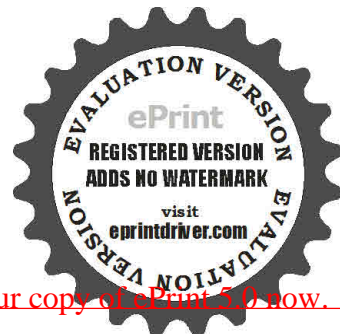
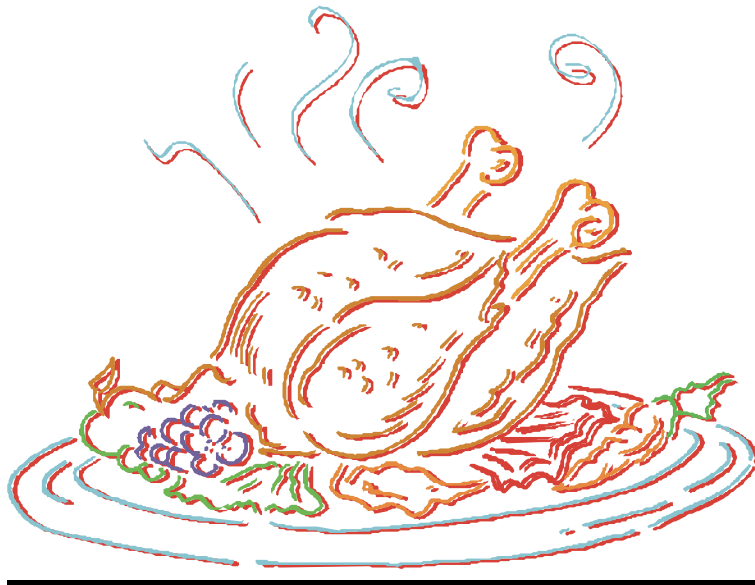

# Puzzle Time

6. Exchequer Academy and Hauer Prep didn't both win medals in horsemanship.
7. Pippley Prep didn't win the Bronze medal for shooting.
8. Exchequer Academy picked up a medal for swimming, but it wasn't Bronze.
9. Neither Crustacean Brothers Academy nor Hauer Prep won the Gold for horsemanship.

Event	Gold	Silver	Bronze



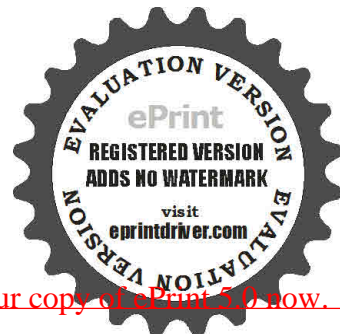

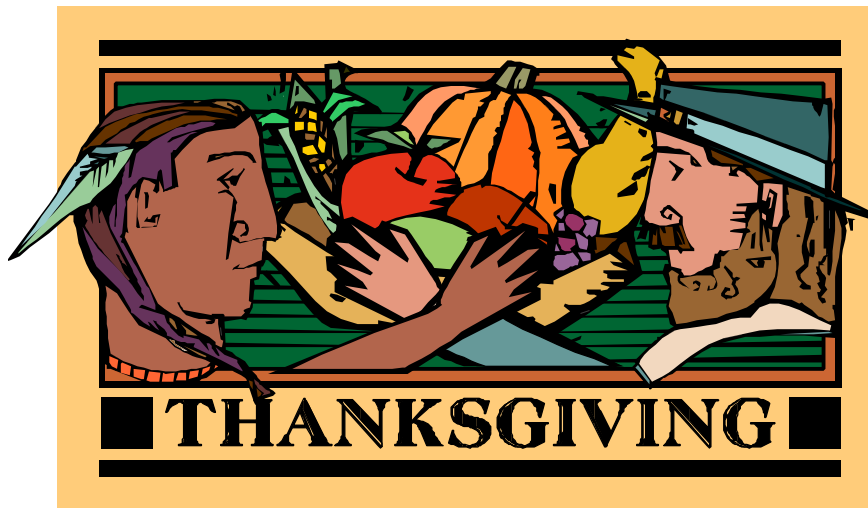

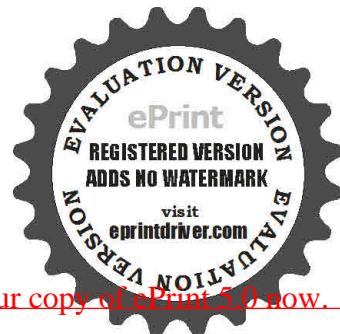
